

THE GOOD NEWS OF JUSTICE

What is justice? We don't know it. If we seen it pass by, we would say, "What is that?" It is a foreign thing on earth, for justice is not of the earth. God establishes just decrees and laws — He establishes righteousness; He gives us His Word that we may practice justice, that we may know what is right; but none of us know His Word, no-one regards Him; we have all turned away from Him; as it is written, "**Behold, I have found only this, that God made men upright, but they have sought out many devices.**" (Ecclesiastes 7:29) They commit wrong; no-one practices truth; they love lies, deceit and bribes; trickery is under their tongue; therefore, there is no justice, there is no peace.
